Notice to Mariners

Overview

Please be advised that XOCEAN, on behalf of Bellrock Offshore Wind Farm Limited, are continuing a geophysical survey “the **Geophysical Survey**” within a potential offshore cable export corridor associated the Bellrock Offshore Wind Farm. The Geophysical Survey is estimated to take 60 days to complete (between 9 August 2026 and 30 November 2026 allowing for weather and operational constraint).The Geophysical Survey commenced on **9 August 2026**.

Please also be advised that INSPIRE, on behalf of Bellrock Offshore Wind Farm Limited, will be undertaking a benthic survey “the **Benthic Survey**” within the same potential offshore cable export corridor associated the Bellrock Offshore Wind Farm. The Benthic Survey is estimated to take up to 25 days to complete (between 14 September 2026 and 31 October 2026 allowing for weather and operational constraint).

This is an update to the Notice to Mariners issued on the 31 July 2026, to reflect additional vessel details for the **Geophysical Survey** and inclusion of the Benthic Survey. Further updates may be issued as the Geophysical Survey and Benthic Survey progresses. Separate Notice to Mariners will be published should alternative offshore cable export corridors be surveyed.

Description of the Geophysical Survey

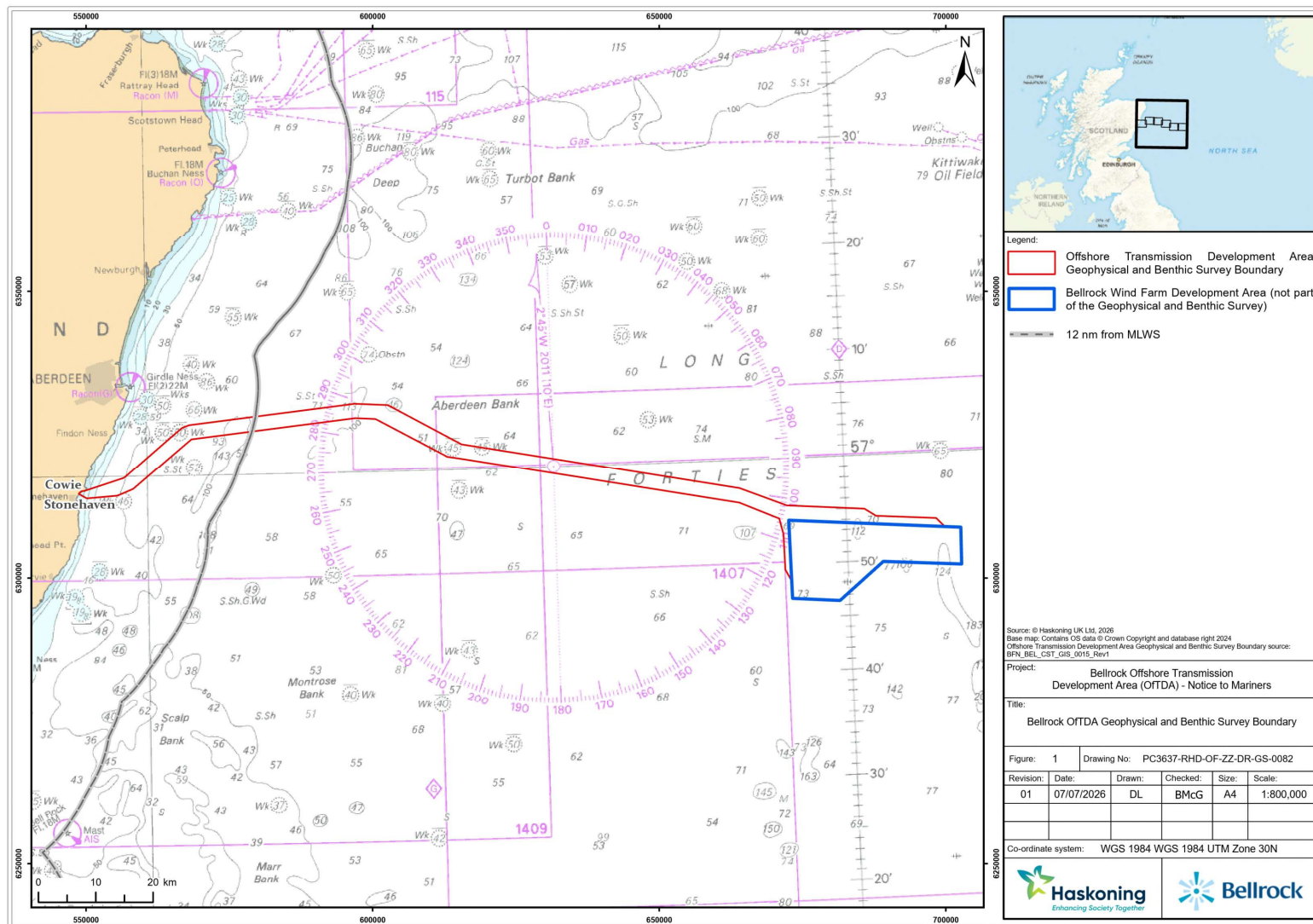
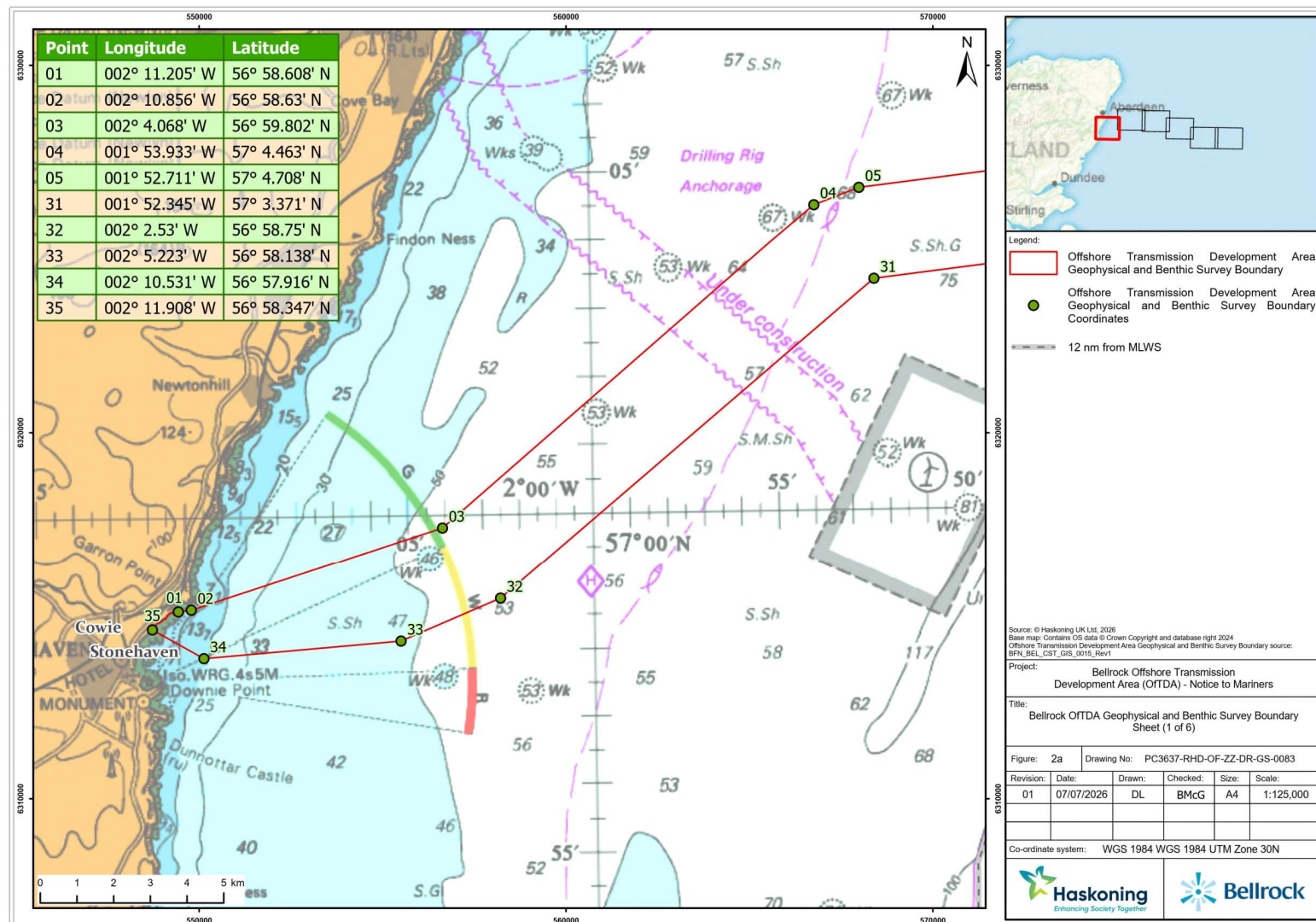


Figure 2a: Location of the Geophysical and Benthic Survey Boundary

The Geophysical Survey will be undertaken within the area shown on Figure 1, and Figure 2a to 2f and Table 1 below. Multiple vessels will be utilised during the Geophysical Survey:

- One geophysical survey vessel;
- Up to four unmanned surface vessels (USV) carrying geophysical survey equipment; and
- One support vessel.

Details of the vessels being used for the Geophysical Survey are provided in Table 2 below.

The Geophysical Survey vessel and USVs will be utilising hull-mounted and towed geophysical survey equipment which requires manoeuvring space. A non-geophysical support vessel for the USVs will also be utilised. The survey campaign is expected to take approximately 60 days to complete (between 9 August 2026 and 30 November 2026), subject to weather and operational constraints. Although the USVs are uncrewed, they are remotely piloted throughout their 24-hour operation, sending real time images and situational awareness data over satellite for monitoring. The situational awareness aids available are listed below.

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Description of the Benthic Survey

The Benthic Survey will be undertaken within the area shown on Figure 1, and Figure 2a to 2f and Table 1 below. A single vessel will be utilised during the Benthic Survey:

Details of the vessel being used for the Benthic Survey is provided in Table 3 below.

The Benthic Survey will involve drop-down camera imagery and benthic grab sampling, and will be undertaken at each sampling location. Sampling locations will be distributed along the offshore export cable corridor shown in Figure 1 at approximately 1.5 km intervals. Around 130 sampling locations will be targeted.

The Benthic Survey will work around fishing gear, fishing vessel operators will not be requested to remove gear.

The Benthic Survey is expected to take approximately 25 days to complete (between 14 September 2026 and 31 October 2026), subject to weather and operational constraints.

Geophysical and Benthic Survey Area

The Geophysical Survey and Benthic Survey will be taken in the area shown in Figure 1 and Figures 2a to 2f, and within the coordinates provided in Table 1.



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Figure 1: Location of the Geophysical and Benthic Survey Boundary

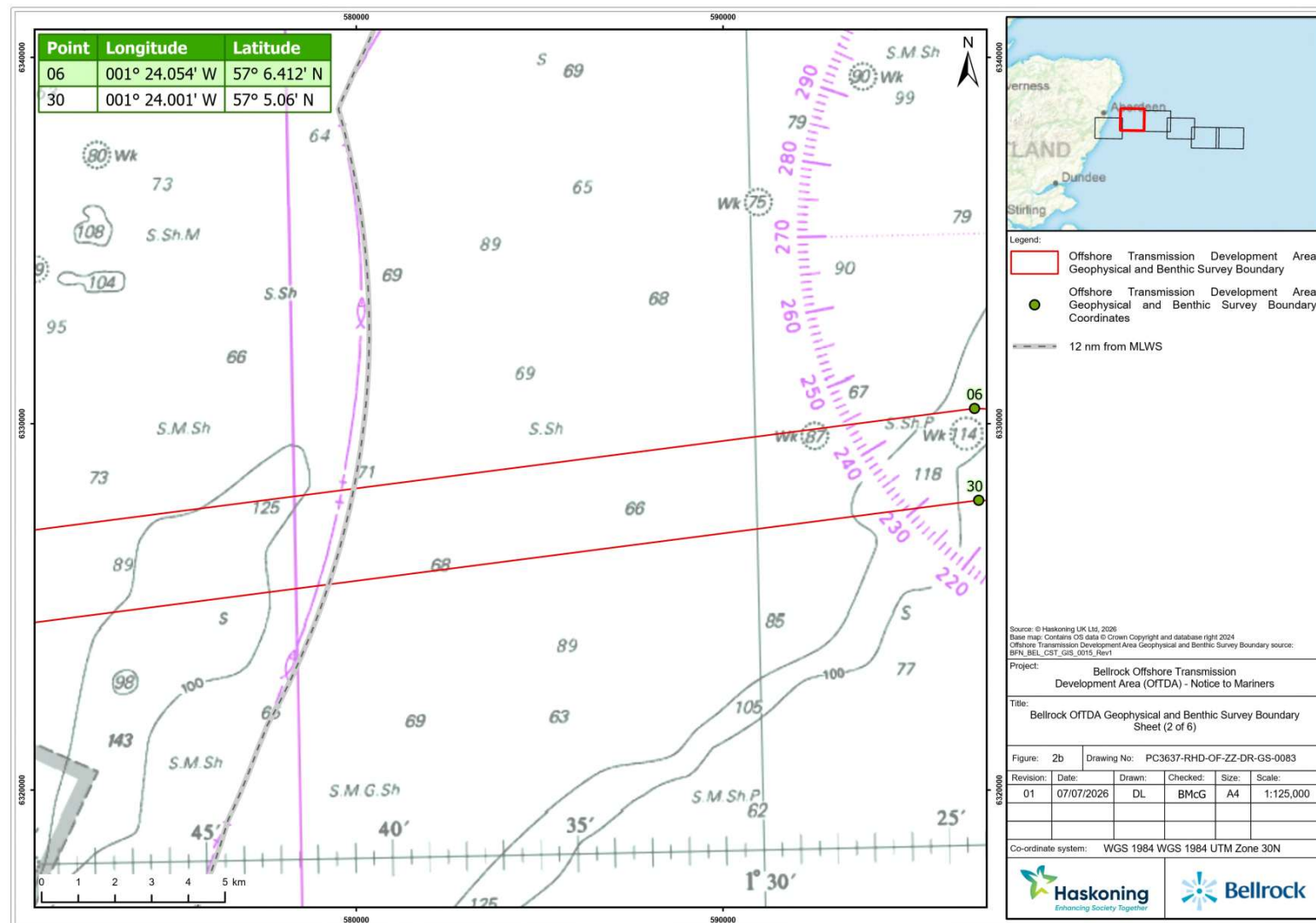
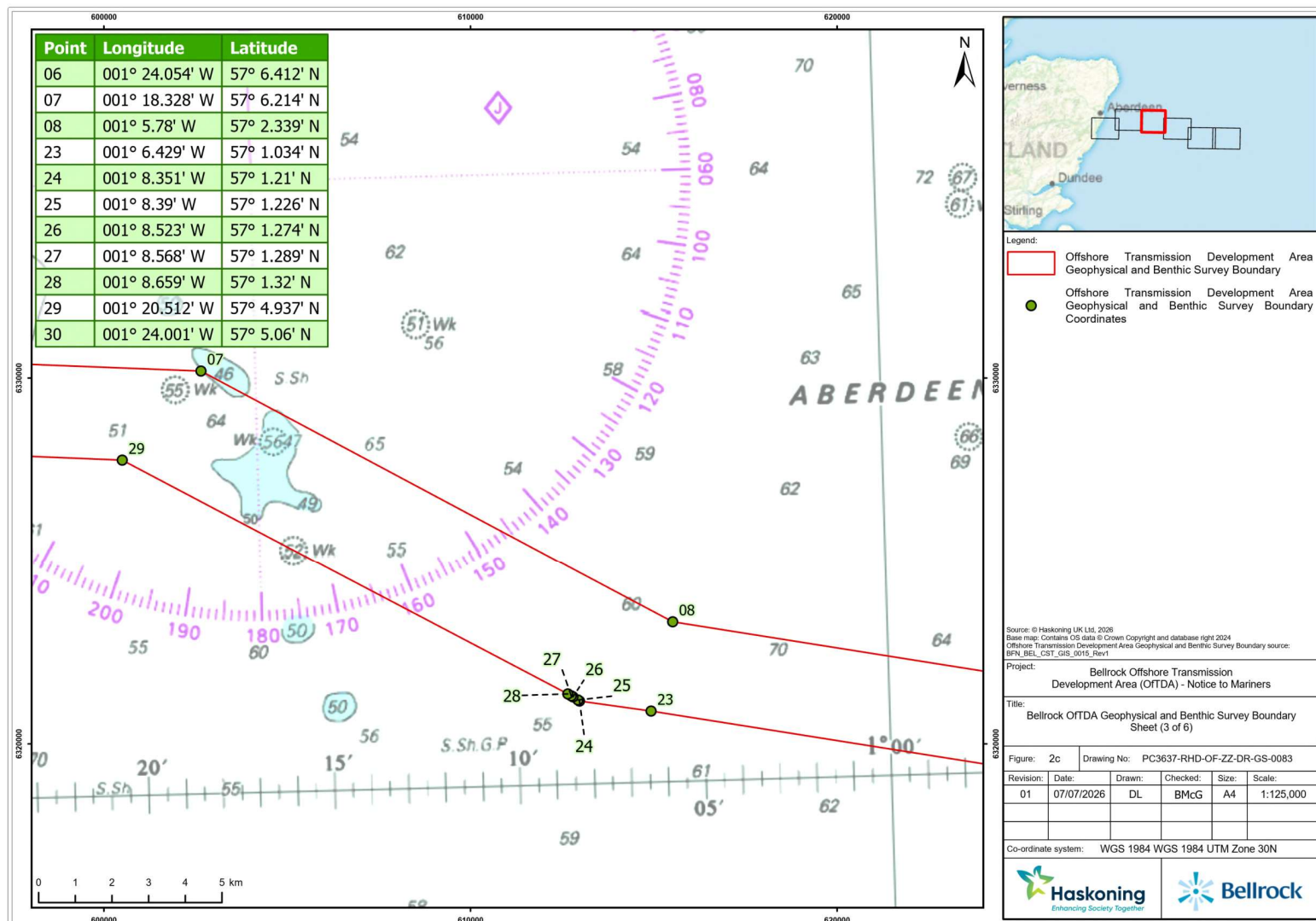
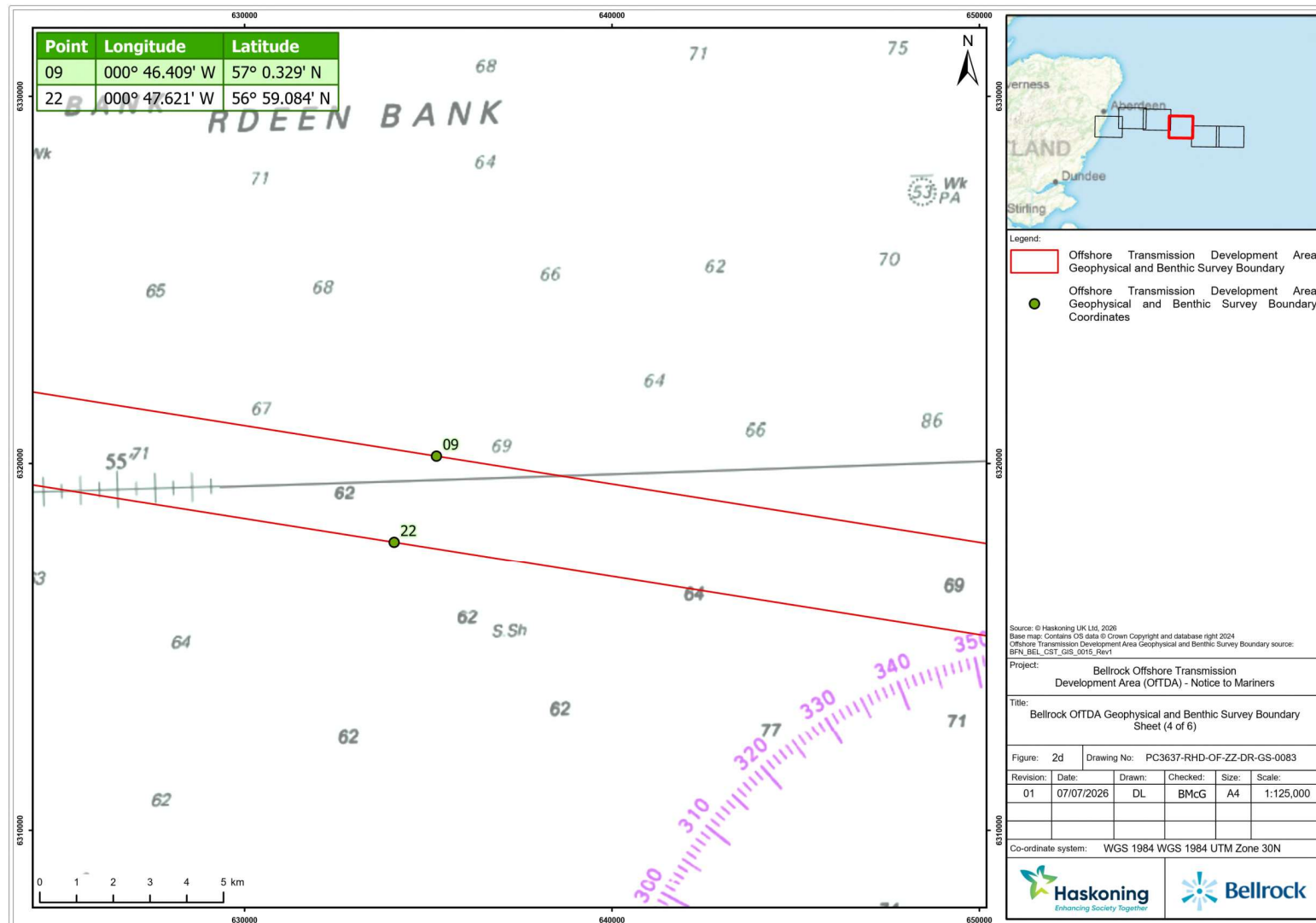


Figure 2c: Location of the Geophysical and Benthic Survey Boundary



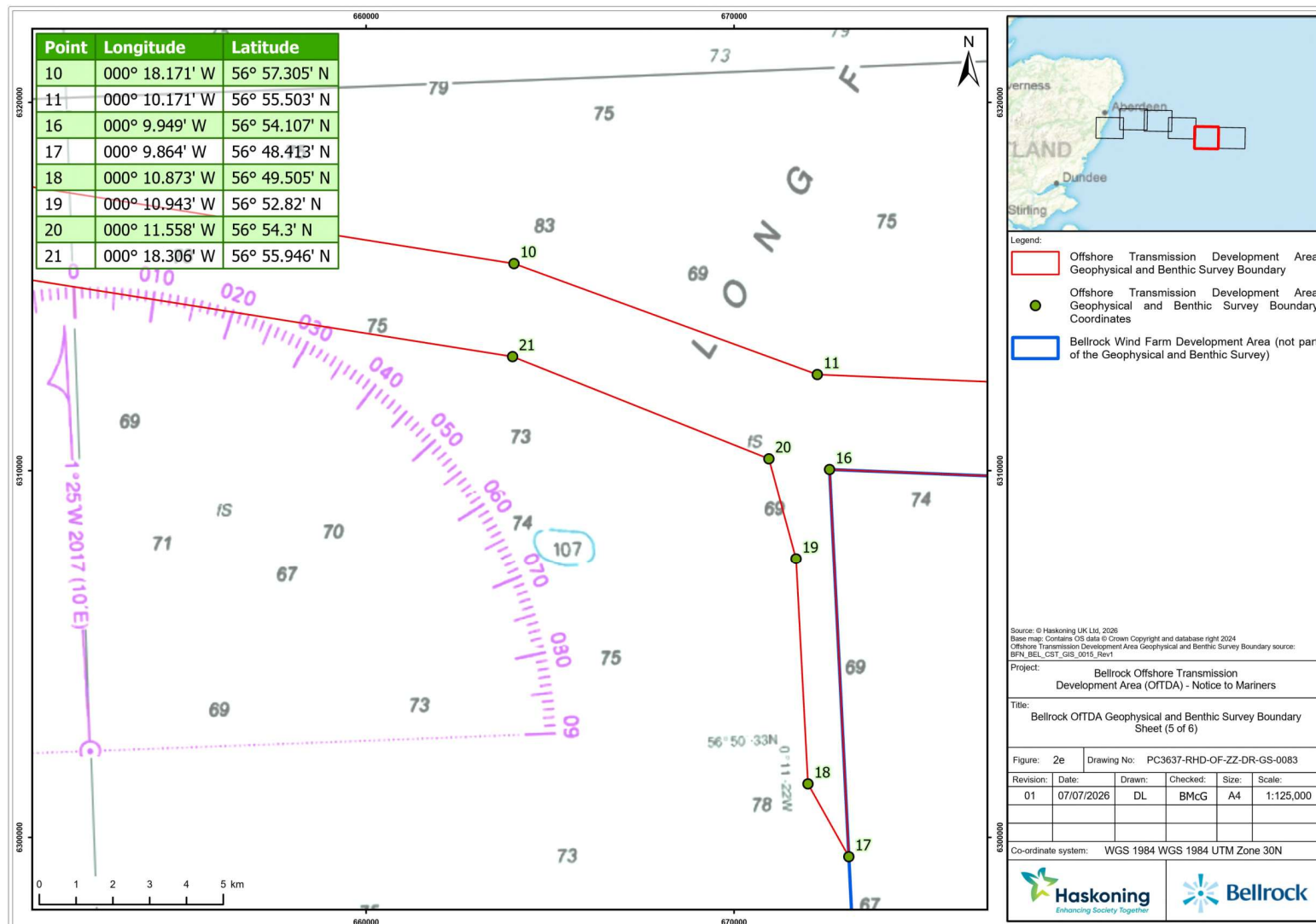
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Figure 2d: Location of the Geophysical and Benthic Survey Boundary



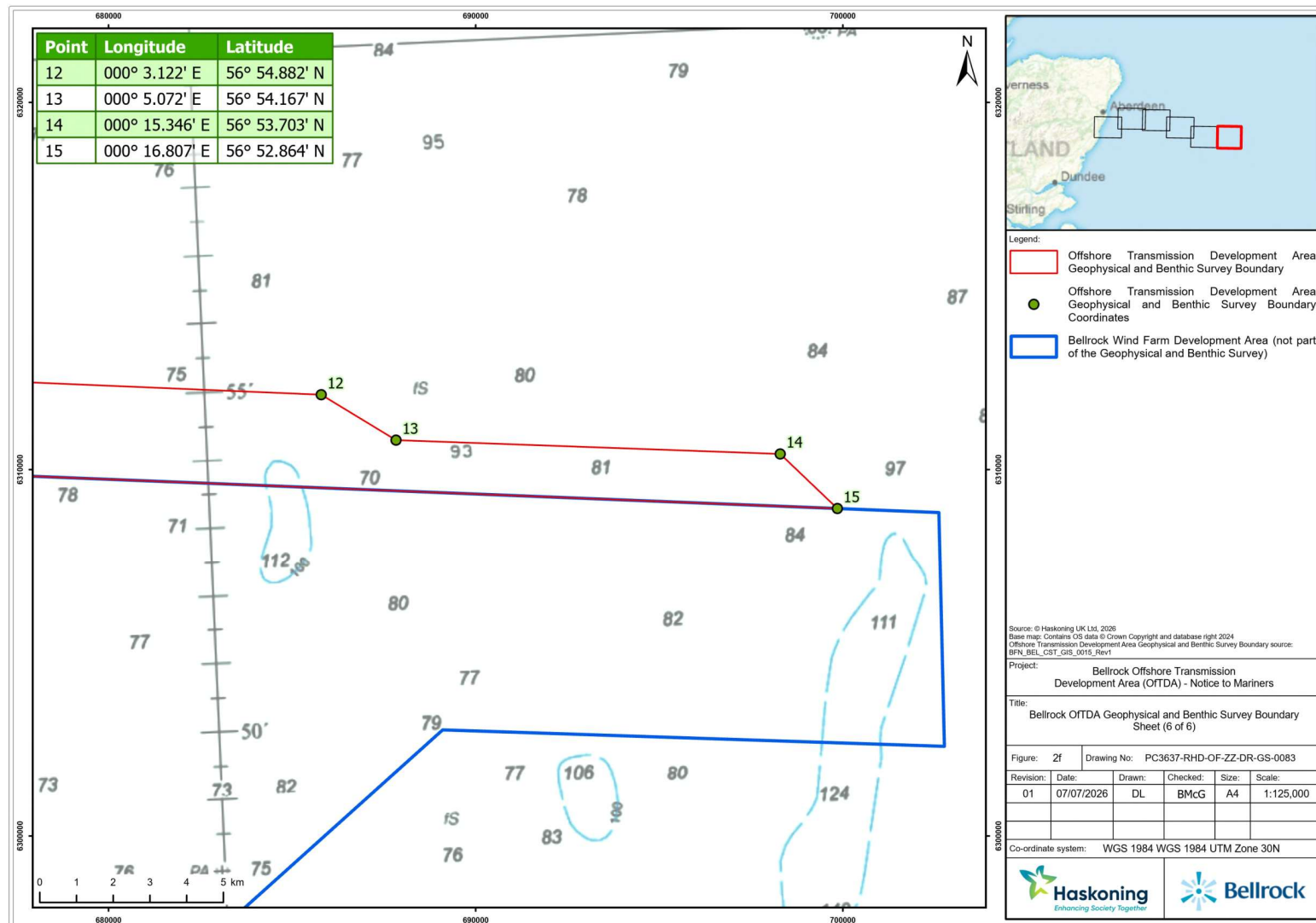
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Figure 2e: Location of the Geophysical and Benthic Survey Boundary

Safety Advice

It is requested that all vessels operating in proximity to the Geophysical Survey and Benthic Survey vessels keep a safe distance of at least 500 metres and pass at minimum speed/reduced wash.

The Benthic Survey vessel when engaged in sampling will be restricted in ability to manoeuvre. Should any vessel wish to come within 500 m of the vessel, then direct communication with the Master/Operator is required. The vessels will display the appropriate lights/day shapes for their operations.

During the Geophysical and Benthic Survey, a listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 16 and the appropriate channel as per requirements where operating within a port authority area.
