

Ei208 Carbon Monoxide Alarms

Important checks:

1. Test the alarms weekly by pressing and holding the Test button on the alarm until all the alarms sound
2. Keep your alarms clean - the alarms may be cleaned externally with a narrow nozzle of a vacuum cleaner and wiped down with a clean damp cloth
3. Do not paint the alarms. This may cause false alarms, impair performance and may damage components inside the alarm

What to do if your alarms sound:

If the alarm sounds, **never assume it is a false alarm**. Follow the steps below:

1. Open the doors and windows to ventilate the area.
2. Turn off all fuel burning appliances where possible
3. Evacuate the property leaving the doors and windows open.
4. Get medical help immediately for anyone suffering the effects of Carbon Monoxide (CO) poisoning (headache, nausea etc.) and advise that CO poisoning is suspected.
5. Contact your gas/fuel supplier on their emergency number to check all appliances.
6. Do not re-enter the property until the alarm has stopped.
7. Do not use the fuel appliances again before they have been checked.
