2. Today's discussions

- 2.1 Tenants are worried about security in their area, including front and close doors. One close door had been broken on Friday evening. This is not classed currently as an emergency repair as it is a communal area. We will ask for this to be changed.
- 2.2 We discussed the stock control survey which NGHA are currently carrying out. Julie O will check in on any plans for improvements work in this area. Julie M reminded people to let police know about any incidents. There is a police drop-in every Thursday in the Housing Officer from 10am-12pm.
- 2.3 Susan reminded the group of the Groups Collective meeting next week, which will be attended by Councillors Siddique and Gallagher. Fionna is the Devon Street rep.
- 2.4 Susan gave update on the GUS M74 skatepark development proposal which is now moving forward. Initial work may start in summer 2026. Tenants would like GUS to come back next year to keep them up to speed on development and timescales. Tenant asked if they could have free membership!
- 2.4 Discussion about redecorating. Eddie confirmed that NGHA do not provide a decorating service.
- 2.5 Local Councillors discussion about which parties they represent. Susan will provide a list for the noticeboard.
- 2.6 Eddie gave an update on the close painting schedule. Closes are currently being painted in Hutchesontown. It is likely to be Cavendish/Devon Street next, hopefully before Christmas.

- 2.7 Query again about uneven cobblestones on Devon Street pavement. Julie O had raised this with GCC previously, but nothing has been done yet. Suggested that Fionna raise this at the meeting with Councillors next week.
- 2.8 Discussion about lack of parking. Suggested that tenants could request a disabled parking bay, as some have blue badges. Tenant will look into this online.
- 2.9 Offer of "Pizza Monday" thanks to an initiative by the Clutha pub. Tenants would be keen to take this up starting next Monday. This will tie in with the time for their quiz. The quiz team is known as the "Devon Street Dodgers". They are now in the Top Ten of the Wheatley Quiz League vying for the trophy.
