1. Welcome and introductions

1.1 Susan welcomed everyone and thanked them for coming. Everyone introduced themselves. We ran over housekeeping and guidelines for meetings.

2. Minutes and actions from the last meeting on 28th October 2025

- 2.1 Further questions on rent increase proposal and processes will be discussed this evening.
- 2.2 Tracey will arrange for help for one tenant with Tenant Portal at same time as gas check is being carried out. Other tenant in office on Wednesday and will ask for help then.
- 2.3 Susan had contacted Officers from a local Council who had been at TIS event discussing their process of providing rent increase proposal options. They explained that the choices they provide (currently 2 options) are not set in stone but examples of what could be done with the money to provide a perspective of where the money goes. Suggestion that tenants could ask for a breakdown of the budget for last year to see exactly where the money goes. This year they are organising an event to

explain what they did with the budgets last year and to check if they are getting the proposals right this year. Officers suggested they can provide more information after this event. Perhaps tenants would like to know what NGHA is spending the rent money on rather than looking for proposed ideas for increases? Susan will keep in touch for updates.

- 2.4 Some tenants said they were not getting repairs text messages. Tracey will follow up.
- 2.5 Discussion on role of management committee which is to make final business decisions based on information provided by the Director and staff team. Committee will interrogate that information to be assured it is the best option before agreeing proposals.

3. Feedback on rent increase proposal

- 3.1 One of the recommendations made by Tenants Panel to improve the rent proposal process, was to offer workshops. A number of these are taking place over the next few weeks to make sure people have the chance to give their feedback. There is one taking place at the community meal this evening with the Housing Operations Manager and tonight the Panel will also have their chance, having received the rent increase proposal information.
- 3.2 The Panel split into 2 groups in separate spaces to make it easier for individuals to give their feedback in smaller groups.

The groups discussions lasted 45 minutes. Tracey and Gregor will note feedback from their groups to be shared with the Panel before the next meeting. Susan thanked everyone for taking part and Gregor and Tracey for facilitating. Gregor encouraged everyone to complete their questionnaires.

4. Any other business

- 4.1 Susan reminded the group that voting was now open for the Gorbals Ideas Fund (GIF) and to go online please to do this. She handed out a couple of the special edition GIF newsletters which showed which ideas had been put forward for this next stage. Tenant also explained there would be a voting roadshow from next week, where you could drop in to several venues to find out more.
