Contaminated surfaces	Persons coming in to contact with contaminated surfaces may contract or spread the infection	Employees, Traders, Car Booters, General Public	High	 Cleaning regimes to be increased in high touch areas such as toilets, door handles, handrails etc. Hand washing facilities to be open and fully functional at all times Hand sanitiser stations to be positioned at entrance to market and all internal areas Display signage to remind visitors to wash hands regularly Increase the number of litter bins to encourage customers to carry tissues and place in bin after coughing or sneezing Catering units to remove shared condiments and to issue pre-pack units when requested 	Med
