

Don't fly near airports or airfields
Remember to stay below 400ft (120m)
Observe your drone at all times - stay $150 \mathrm{ft}(50 \mathrm{~m})$ away from people and property
Never fly near aircraft
Enjoy responsibly $400 \mathrm{ft}(120 \mathrm{~m})$

## BE DRONE SAFE

Always keep your drone in sight


This means you can see and avoid other things while flying

From 30th November 2019 and for drones over 250 g , you must pass the drone test and register with the CAA before you fly

Passing the test and registering will help
keep you and others safe

You are responsible for each flight


[^0]Failure to fly responsibly could result in criminal prosecution

It's against the law to fly your drone over 400ft (120m)

This reduces the likelihood of a conflict with manned aircraft

## Keep the right distance from

 people and property

People and properties - 150ft (50m)
Crowds and built up areas - 500ft ( $\mathbf{1 5 0 m}$ ) and don't overfly

Stay well away from aircraft, airports and airfields when flying any drone.

It is illegal to fly them
inside the airport's flight restriction zone without permission.

If your drone endangers the safety of an aircraft it is a criminal offence and you could go to prison for five years
