Where to report to on arrival

Full-time students

Students should report to the reception area at the centre upon arrival. The receptionist will be able to point you in the right direction, but please be sure to arrive in plenty of time.

Part-time students

If you are attending a part-time course at Ellon Learning Centre, you should report to the Reception area at the centre on arrival. The member of staff will direct you to the classroom from there. You should aim to arrive about 10-15 minutes before the class is due to start.

Parking

The NESCol staff and student car park is located behind the learning centre (once you have turned left into the main entrance leading to the community campus, keep heading along that road - the last entrance on your right leads you to parking areas). NESCol car parking is located on first right. The car park is signposted. Please note parking is available on a first come, first served basis.

The Ellon Learning Centre is also well served by local transport links, with buses leaving the centre of Aberdeen regularly, and buses from other rural towns and villages available as well.

Where to eat

There are no catering facilities on-site. There is a drinks machine and cold water machine which students can use. Within the community campus itself, there is a community café which is open in the evenings and outwith school hours.

What to bring to the first class

If you do need to bring any equipment or materials to your first class, you will receive instructions before the class starts. However, in most cases, you will be told by your tutor on the first class what to bring with you. You can also check on our website if anything is required by checking the course descriptor for your chosen course.
