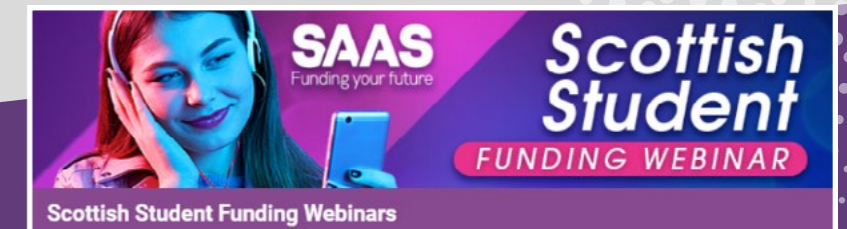

IAN LITTLEJOHN

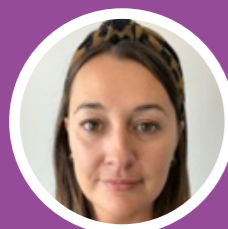
