

From the 19th July Scotland will move into tier 0. This has been a long time coming and we all hope it's the final step to the relaxation of most if not all of the covid restrictions.

What does this mean for the clubhouse and the social functions? The changes are outlined below.

1. We will now be able to accept bookings for lunches and high teas for table sizes of up to 10 people from 4 households indoors and 15 people from 15 households outside. Children under the age of 12 don't count towards the total.
2. Whilst it is not a legal requirement to book tables we would still ask that you do continue to book as it allows us to plan ahead for menu choices and servings. Please continue to book at bookings@royaltay.org.
3. We have decided to stop the Wednesday lunches as from end of July but they will continue on Thursdays and Fridays. The coffee club will still have its place on a Wednesday morning.
4. We are now able to open up until 11pm on a Tuesday and Friday evening to allow more flexibility in meeting friends.
5. Unfortunately 1m social distancing is still in place indoors so please be aware of this when visiting the clubhouse and any other RTYC property.
6. Facemasks indoors are still compulsory when not seated at your table.

We are all used to this by now so all we ask is for your cooperation in continuing to make the RTYC a covid safe environment.

With the restrictions easing we have decided to restart small to medium sized member and external function bookings up until Dec 24th 2021. These can be booked outwith the club opening times where possible.
