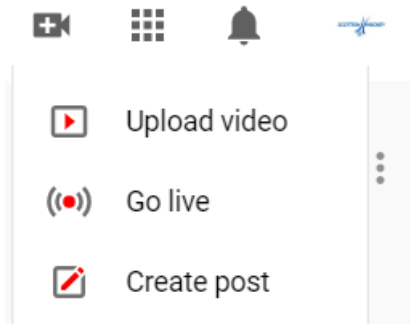


Uploading a video to YouTube



In the top right corner you'll see these symbols. Click the first one (the camera)



A dropdown menu will appear. Click Upload Video.



Drag and drop video files to upload
Your videos will be private until you publish them.

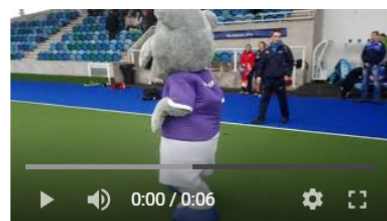
