FORMAT AND RULES

U16 GIRLS CUP

- Four pools of four teams each (total 16 teams)
- Teams plays each other once within their pool, with points being awarded as follows:
 - Win: 3 points
 - Draw: 1 point
 - Loss: 0 points
- Teams will play home or away as determined by the competition fixture list.
- All matches must be played by the 'Play-By' dates listed on the fixture list.
- At the end of the pool matches, the positions will be determined using the criteria in the competition rules, i.e. most points, then most wins, then goal difference, etc.
- The **top team** in each pool (four teams) will qualify for the cup finals on **Sunday 20 March 2022** at Peffermill, Edinburgh.
- Matches should be **four quarters of 15 minutes** with a 2-minute break between quarters and a 5-minute half-time break.
- All matches will be 11-a-side and played on a full pitch.
- Running penalties will not be used in the pool matches – only in finals on 20 March.
- Please refer to the Competition Rules issued to each participating Club and available on the Scottish Hockey website, under [Competitions – Youth Hockey](#).
- Teams do not have to complete a Match Report Form for Pool matches.
- Both teams should email the result to the Competitions mailbox at Scottish Hockey: competitions@scottish-hockey.org.uk within 24 hours of the match ending.
