Reset, Build, Excel – an ambitious vision for Scottish Hockey

Our vision needs to be ambitious to reflect our community. We intend on creating a strategy that underpins this vision, and consultation with our members & key-stakeholders for this exciting and ambitious strategy will start this April. Reset, Build & Excel is our 3-stage approach to achieving our vision of being a professional, commercially sustainable, visible, diverse and world class governing body over a ten-year period. We have significant ambitions to be a governing body that sets the standards for others and one that has an impact on and off the pitch. We want to Excel in equality, inclusion, welfare, participation, performance, and commercial success. We do not want to be left behind by other sports and want to be at the forefront of modern technology and creating a sport that appeals to all.

Main purpose of the role

The Vice President is expected to be an ambassador for our sport and promote the work of Scottish Hockey, increasing awareness of its values and objectives. The Vice President deputises or collaborates with the president in representing Scottish Hockey at public events and prize giving ceremonies.

This is a non-salaried position. Travel and other reasonable out-of-pocket expenses will be reimbursed for attendance at official meetings and events on

behalf of Scottish Hockey. The term of office is for two years with an opportunity for a further 2-year reappointment, following formal election at the Annual General Meeting, usually in June.

Responsibilities

In the absence, or alongside the President, the Vice President must

- Act as a figurehead of Scottish Hockey as the governing body of hockey in Scotland and represent and promote Scottish Hockey at public events, when dealing with other sports governing bodies or International organisations and attending the principal Scottish Hockey events.
- Promote the work of Scottish Hockey, raising awareness and encouraging participation, equality, diversity and inclusion.
- Act with integrity, at all times, upholding the values of Scottish Hockey.
- Be fully briefed by the President on the work of the Board and wider organisation.
- The Vice President is not a director of Scottish Hockey and as such has no voting rights.
