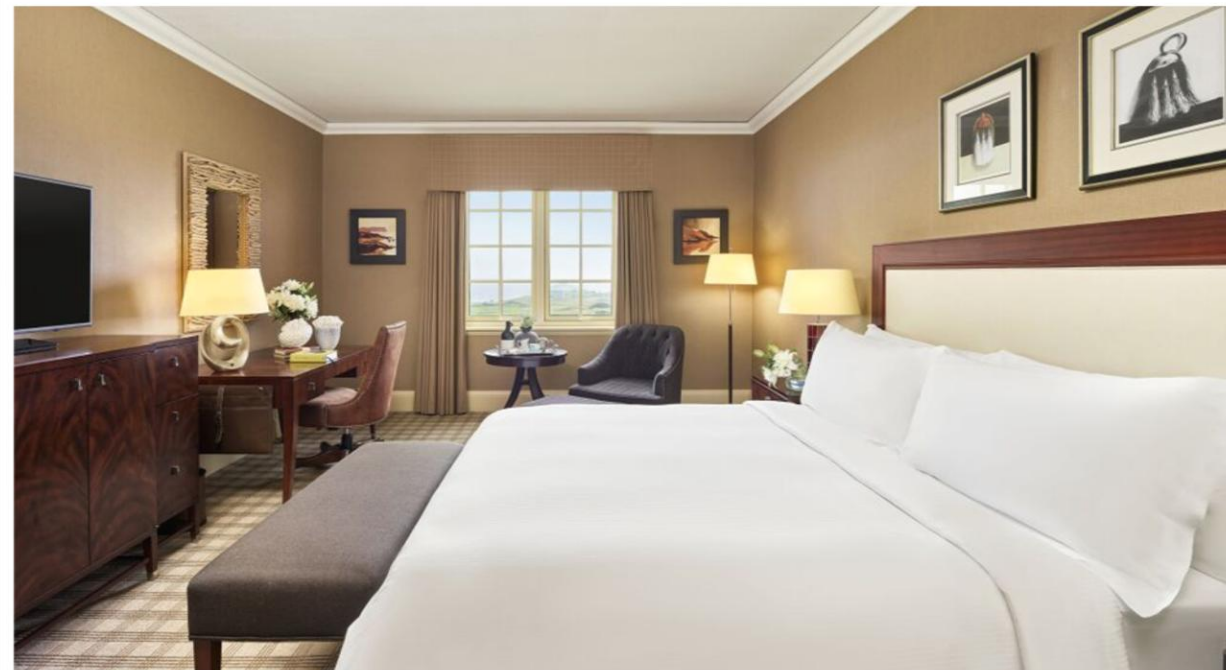

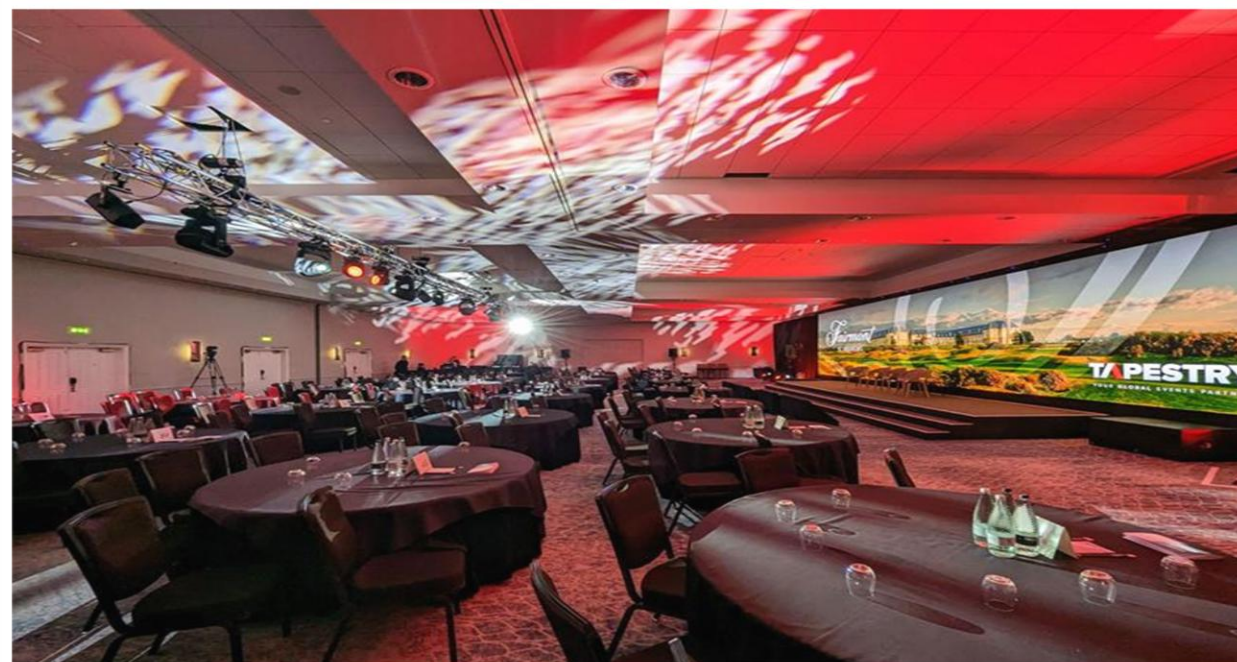

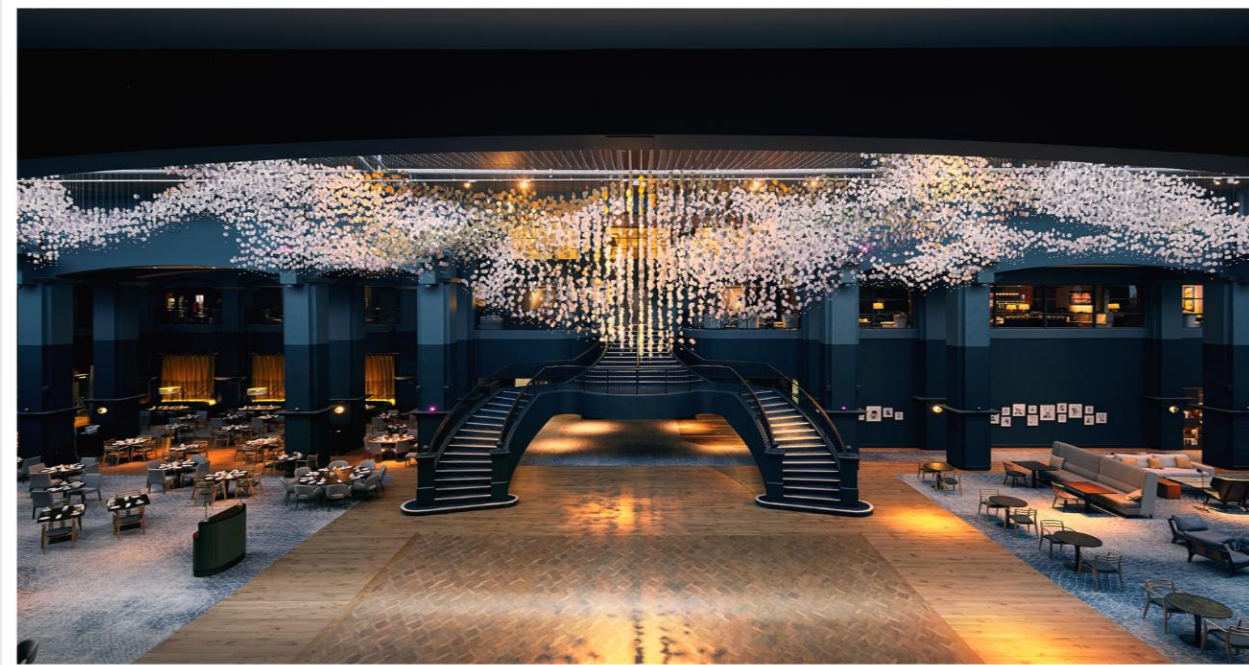

After your round, unwind with a two or three-course lunch at our elegant clubhouse, offering iconic panoramic views over the courses and St Andrews Bay.



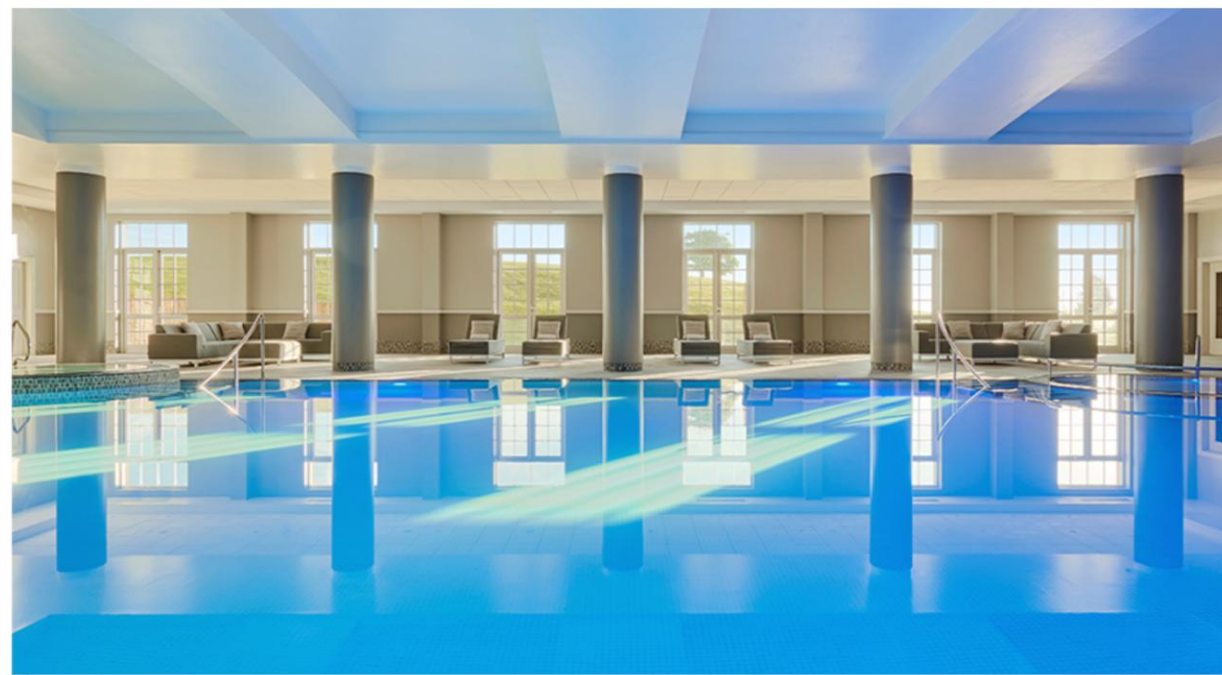

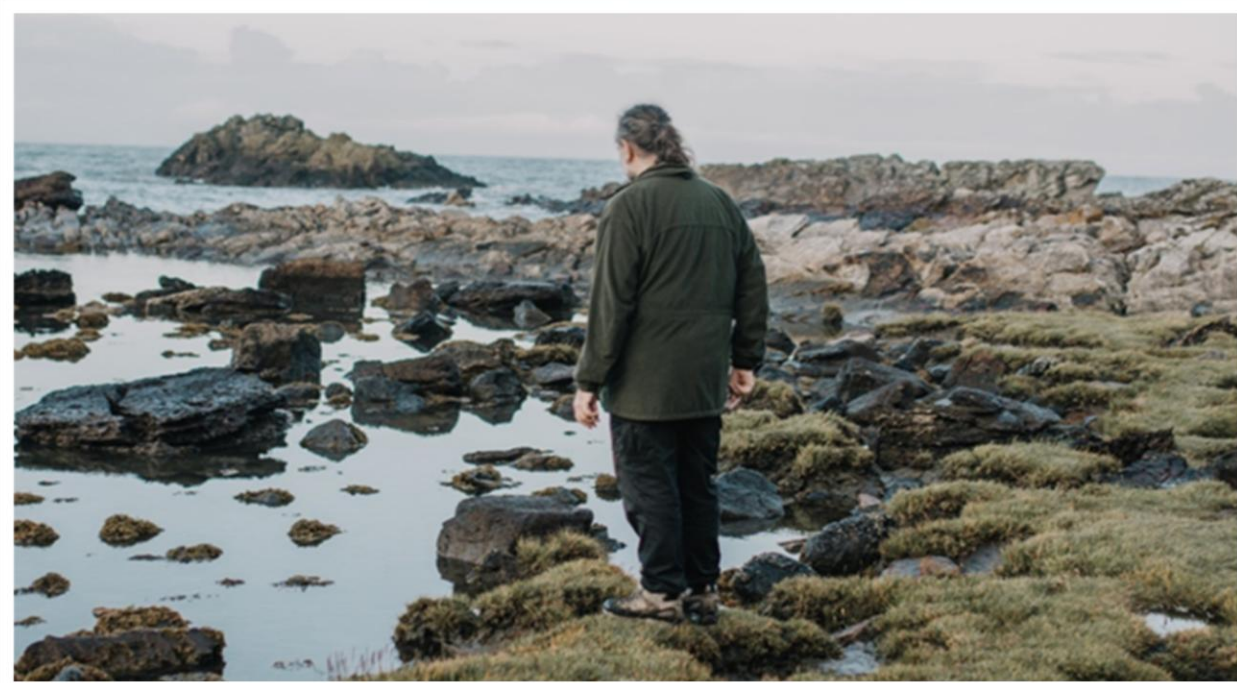
DISCOVER *hidden* TREASURES

GETTING *here*

Chauffeur Service

Our resort transport department operates an airport 'Meet and Greet' service, private transfers and tours with our fleet of executive vehicles.

Driving Direction

Driving from Edinburgh - Take Queensferry Crossing on to the M90. At junction 8, take the A91 exit to St Andrews and continue on A91. At St Andrews follow A917 for Crail. Fairmont St Andrews is approximately 2.0 miles on the left.

Complimentary overnight parking is available. Complimentary valet parking is also available on arrival for hotel guests. Disabled parking is at the side entrance of the resort. 6 EV charging spaces have been installed at Fairmont St Andrews' main car park. They operate on a first-come, first-served basis and are priced at 40p per Kw through a third-party application TapElectric.

Taxi

Approximate cost is £25.00 from Leuchars Train Station to Fairmont, St. Andrews. Costs may vary for airport transfers.

Arriving By Air

Edinburgh Airport is located approximately 84 km / 52 miles/ 60 minute drive from the resort. Take the scenic route from Edinburgh Airport to St Andrews, driving through picturesque fishing villages(adds approximately 30 minutes to the journey).

Glasgow Airport is located approximately 119 km / 74 miles / 2 hour drive from the resort.

For those wishing to arrive at the hotel by helicopter, a helipad is situated at the front of the hotel.
